32 clubs share CHF 631 million from UEFA Champions League 2003/04

UEFA today disclosed the share of revenue distribution among the 32 clubs taking place in the UEFA Champions League 2003/04 from the Group Stage onwards.

A total amount of CHF 631 million was available for distribution to the clubs, an amount representing some 75%-82% of the total revenue, as per the competition regulations.

The figures show that winners FC Porto netted a total of CHF 29.98 million, while runners-up AS Monaco collected CHF 40.08 million due to their higher revenue from the Market Pool. English clubs Arsenal FC, Manchester United FC and Chelsea FC also all netted over CHF 40 million for their endeavours in the competition.

The distribution of the revenue generated by UEFA from television rights and sponsorship deals is split among the participating clubs according to fixed amounts including; a starting bonus (CHF 2.5 million), a match bonus in group matches (CHF 0.5 million), a performance bonus in group matches (CHF 0.5 million per win, 0.25 million per draw), a knock-out round bonus (CHF 2.5 million), a quarter-final bonus (CHF 3.0 million), a semi-final bonus (CHF 4.0 million) and then CHF 6.0 million for the runner-up and CHF 10 million for the winner.

Added to this is the Market Pool, which is distributed according to the proportional value of each TV market represented by the clubs taking part, and is split among the number of teams participating from a given association. Half of this amount per market is split among the clubs based on their performance in the previous domestic league championship and the other half is paid in proportion to the number of matches played by each team in the 2003/04 UEFA Champions Leagues.

UEFA's 52 member associations will benefit financially from the solidarity payments made by UEFA to all associations to support grassroots football. In addition those clubs that were participating in but were knocked out before the Group Stage of the UEFA Champions League, or eliminated in the second round or earlier of the UEFA Cup, will receive a further solidarity payment.

A full breakdown of payments made to the associations will be available in the forthcoming edition of *uefadirect*, UEFA's football family magazine, due out at the end of June.
