

1. Ice sailing

The leader of a school newspaper asks you to help with editing the sports section. Create the article about ice sailing according to the example. Use files *jegvit.txt* and *balaton.jpg* as sources.

1. Create a new document in your word processor and then save it as *jeges* in the default format of the word processor. From here on, work with this file. Margins: 2 cm.
2. You already have the first part of the article in handwriting, type it into the document created in the previous step.

3. Insert the content of file *jegvit.txt* at the end of the document, after this text.
4. The title “Ice sailing” should be formatted as follows: the font size is 20 points, the font colour is blue, the font style is bold, italics and the text is expanded. The font type of the title should be different from the font type of the remaining text and it should be aligned centered.
5. The first paragraph of the typed text after the title should be aligned justified, the indent of the first line should be half centimetre.
6. The following three lines should form a list and should be indented as shown in the example.
7. The URL address “<http://www.sielok.hu/simania/jegvitorlazaras.htm>” should be converted into italics.
8. There should be a spacing of half of a line after the last typed paragraph.
9. With the exception of the title and the last two paragraphs the text should be aligned justified and the line spacing should be one and a half lines.
10. Insert picture *balaton.jpg* in the document according to the example, on the right. Set the height of the picture to 80% of the original picture but the ratio of the sides should be kept constant. Use a thin black border around the picture.
11. Place the last two paragraphs located in the *.txt* file into a table according to the example.
12. Copy the phone number “Ice sailing: 06-1-234-5678” into each cell of the second row. Change the orientation of the text as shown in the example. The text should be aligned centered within the cell.

13. The background colour of the first row of the table is light grey, the font size is 16 points while in the other cells the font size is only 14 points. The font style should be bold throughout the table.
14. The borders of the table should be as shown in the example. The content of the cell of the first row of the table should be aligned centered both vertically and horizontally.
15. The height of the first row of the table should be exactly 2 cm.

“The domestic ice sailing racing was revived in 1999 after a long pause with the reorganisation of the ice sailing department association. In the preceding years there were no racing rules and suitable equipments in the country. The rules were translated by Gusztáv Koltay, President of the DN association and Levente Nagy, the leader of the referee committee a few years ago. There are both European and World Ice Sailing Championships; what is special and interesting about these championships is that their time is known months before but the site is announced only four days before the contest – the conditions are influenced so much by weather. According to Gusztáv Koltay – who is a racer himself – the ice conditions can change considerably overnight. Wind can smoothen the ice, snow can cover it, rainwater can flood it. Therefore a good ice sailor is always ready for a bit of adventure.”
